TOURNAMENT MORNING PROCESS

- MORNING CHECK-IN PROCEDURE
 - ALL ANGLERS AND CAPTAINS CHECK-IN AT TABLE/STAGE AREA
 - LIGHT MORNING SNACK AND COFFEE/DRINKS PROVIDED (VOLUNTEERS NEEDED)
 - AFTER YOU CHECK-IN PLEASE GET ON THE WATER AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. THIS WILL HELP PREVENT LONG LINES AT THE RAMP.
 - THERE IS A LONG WALK FROM THE RAMP TO THE BOAT PARKING AREA. WE WILL TRY TO HAVE A VEHICLE AVAILABLE TO TRANSPORT BOAT CAPTAINS IN THE MORNING AND IN THE AFTERNOON FROM THE BOAT PARKING AREA TO THE RAMP.
 - PARENTS/GAURDIANS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR ANGLERS AT ALL TIMES

- WEIGH-IN STARTS AT 1 PM
 - JUNIOR DRAW FLIGHT 1: 1 PM
 - JUNIOR TEAM FLIGHT 2: 1:30 PM
 - HIGH SCHOOL FLIGHT 3: 2 PM
 - FLIGHTS MUST CHECK IN WITH TIMEKEEPER AT DOCK!
- TRADITIONAL WALK-UP WEIGH-IN, WE WILL PROVIDE MESH WEIGH-IN BAGS, BOAT CAPTAINS SEE SETH STARKS, MATT SHURA, OR EUGENE LIVAR WITH ANY QUESTIONS ON THE WEIGH-IN PROCESS.
- ALL FISH MUST BE TRANSFERRED INTO PROVIDED MESH BAG
- ANGLERS WILL LINE UP AT THE LARGE BLACK BUMP TANKS
- DRAW WILL BE WEIGHED IN FIRST, FOLLOWED BY JR TEAMS, FINAL WILL BE HIGH SCHOOL: STICK AROUND TO CHEER ON YOUR FELLOW ANGLERS PARENTS/GAURDIANS

ANGLER/COACHING CODE OF CONDUCT REMINDERS:

RULE REMINDERS:

- READ AND OBEY THE RULES
- OFFICIAL PRACTICE DAYS: FRIDAY, Nov. 18th 19th SEE RULE 10
- LIFE JACKET
- NO ANGLERS ALLOWED TO RUN BIG MOTOR
- NO MINIMUM FOR PHOENIX JUNIOR BASSMASTERS AT BARTLETT, 12" MIN FOR ARIZONA HIGH SCHOOL BASSMASTERS, 5 FISH TEAM WEIGHT
- IF A BOAT CAPTAIN OR AN ANGLER GETS OFF THE BOAT, ALL FISHING MUST CEASE UNTIL PARTNERS ARE BACK TOGETHER IN THE BOAT.
- NO ENCROACHMENT OR IMPEDING (TALK TO THE OTHER BOATS)
- BOAT CAPTAINS WILL NOT FISH DURING THE TOURNAMENT, WHICH INCLUDES CASTING LINES OR LURES,
 SETTING THE HOOK, REEL, OR PLAY FISH TO THE BOAT. IF A BOAT CAPTAIN IS CAUGHT DOING SO THE
 ANGLERS MAY BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE TOURNAMENT. FOR EXAMPLE, THE CAPTAIN CANNOT CAST
 AND HAND THE FISHING ROD TO THE ANGLER.
- OFF LIMITS: MARINA (see map) & ANY OTHER BUOYS AS PLACED BY AZ GAME & FISH


